There's nothing better than taking time out and going off-grid – for a little while at least. A far-flung destination that couldn't be further from the daily grind, it's time to take some R&R that's entirely your own.



Miavana, Madagascar

Surround yourself with silence and welcome ultimate seclusion at this remote private island. Even before the helicopter touches down, Miavana begins to enchant with its paradisiacal beachfront location. Make like Robinson Crusoe as you settle into your island-inspired villa – dotted along the untouched sands, off-grid but with luxurious touches aplenty, this is the isolated paradise you’ve been dreaming of. Tick lemur trekking off your bucket list, spot whales and dolphins on a boat cruise or learn to dive to discover vibrant reefs, sea turtles and manta rays.



NIHI Sumba, Indonesia

Sumba’s remoteness makes it trickier than most to get to, but it’s the perfect place for those wanting more than just a beach getaway. From the tempting sight of surf crashing onto the shore to the rhythmic canter of horses clipping the sand, a visit to Indonesia’s ‘forgotten island’ definitely sharpens the senses. Found on the Edge of Wildness™ without the distractions of everyday life, this sustainable lodge lets conscious-castaways firmly focus on the present. While NIHI’s partnership with The Sumba Foundation draws them in with their great efforts to empower the islanders with education and jobs.

Raffles Maldives Meradhoo

Complete pace-slowers, however, bask in the vast open ocean on the separate ring of overwater villas just a short dhoni boat ride away, only emerging for a private chef experience or Balinese spa treatment.



Verdura, A Rocco Forte Hotel, Sicily

Reclining on 570 acres of beachfront miles away from the overpopulated suntraps, Rocco Forte's first venture into building its own hotels is a crowd-pleasing remote affair, where rejuvenation and indulgence lounge side by side. Those looking for sublime seclusion will do well to plump for a stay in one of the pool suites. Woven subtly into the landscape using natural local materials, these lodgings marry the warmth and ambience of Sicily with contemporary restraint; boasting a private pool and beguiling sea views, you need never leave your expansive abode.

Jumby Bay Island, Antigua

Set on its own island off the coast of Antigua, this estate's reputation often precedes it, and for good reason. Much like the Antiguan word that inspired its name (jumbee meaning 'playful spirit'), the laid-back feeling here is present as soon as you step onto the welcome dock. However, the delicate beauty and solitude that characterises Jumby Bay is found best in the Private Residences. Peppered throughout this exclusive private island and complete with staff, these individually designed homes boast anything from enormous pools to a turtle sanctuary.

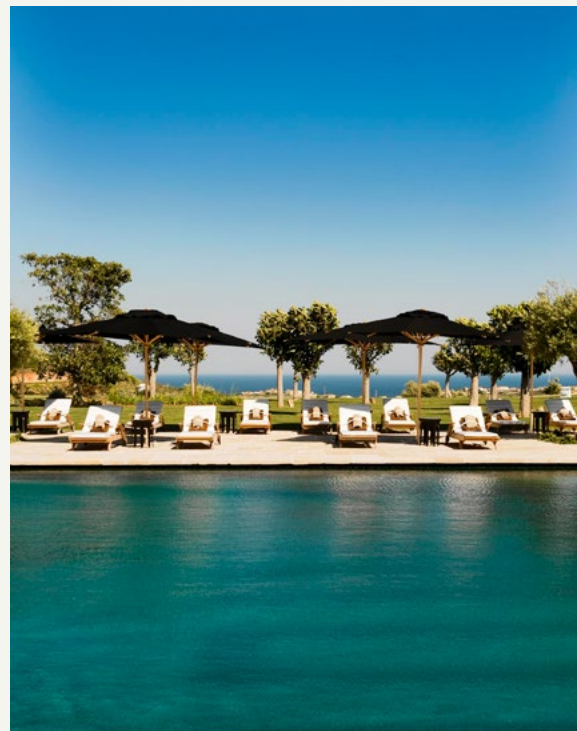
Mandarin Oriental, Canouan, The Grenadines

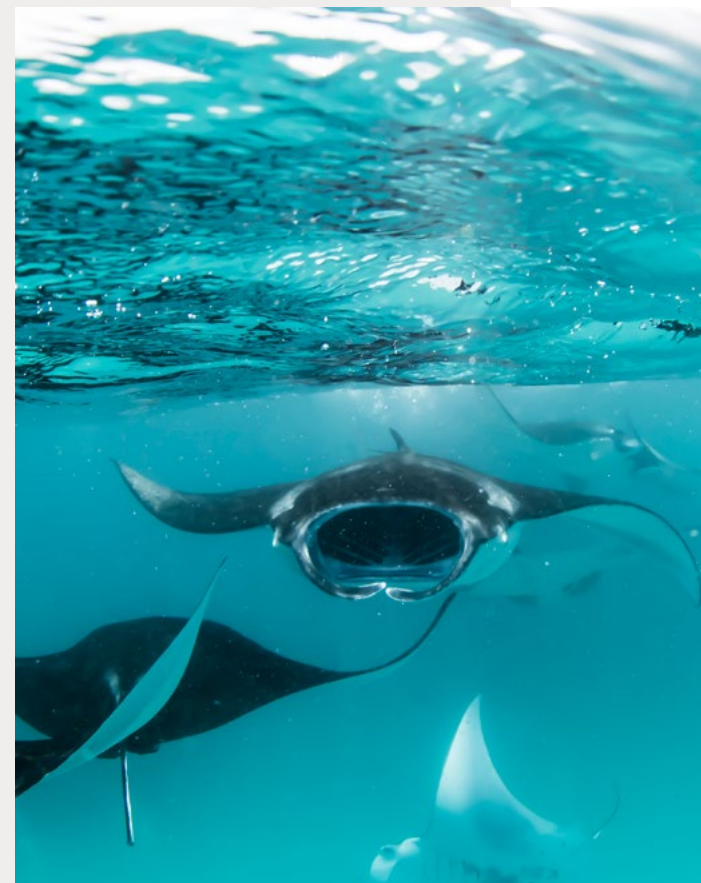
Lengishu, Kenya

Invited to live barefoot and mobile phone free, tuning out of modern life is encouraged the moment you arrive. Instead, distractions here are designed to awaken the senses: exploring jaw-dropping terrain through a spot of kayaking, microlighting and trekking in the canyons, or getting an eyeful of marine life on a snorkelling or diving sortie.

The Datai, Langkawi, Malaysia

The magical isle of Langkawi is a truly remarkable ecological gem bursting with natural wonders begging exploration. Meet Malaysia's answer to Sir David Attenborough at one of Asia's most exclusive resorts, where nemophilists can see all manner of wildlife living and thriving in the surrounding 100-million-year old virgin rainforest. For off the beaten track encounters, join renowned resident naturalist, Irshad Mobarak, to tread the footpaths of the dense forest, kayak through mysterious mangroves and cool off in freshwater jungle pools.
